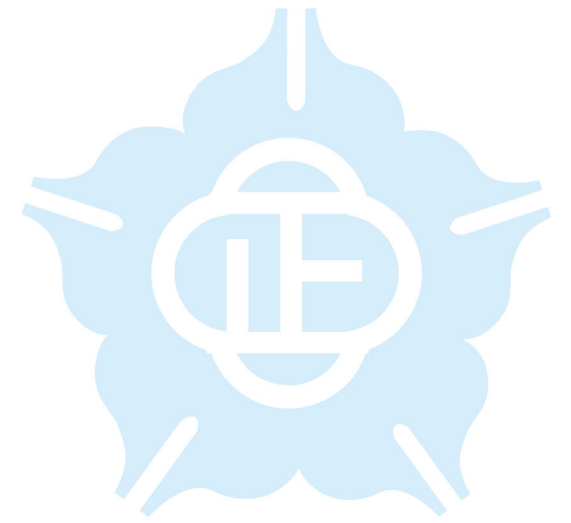

3. 学習効率を高めるために、中正大学の国際サマー・スクールでは、フィールド調査、学生による学習成果の発表、各国の風習体験を催すなど、実際の交流を通じて人間関係を深め、国境を越えた知識を構築して共有のネットワークを作りましょう。

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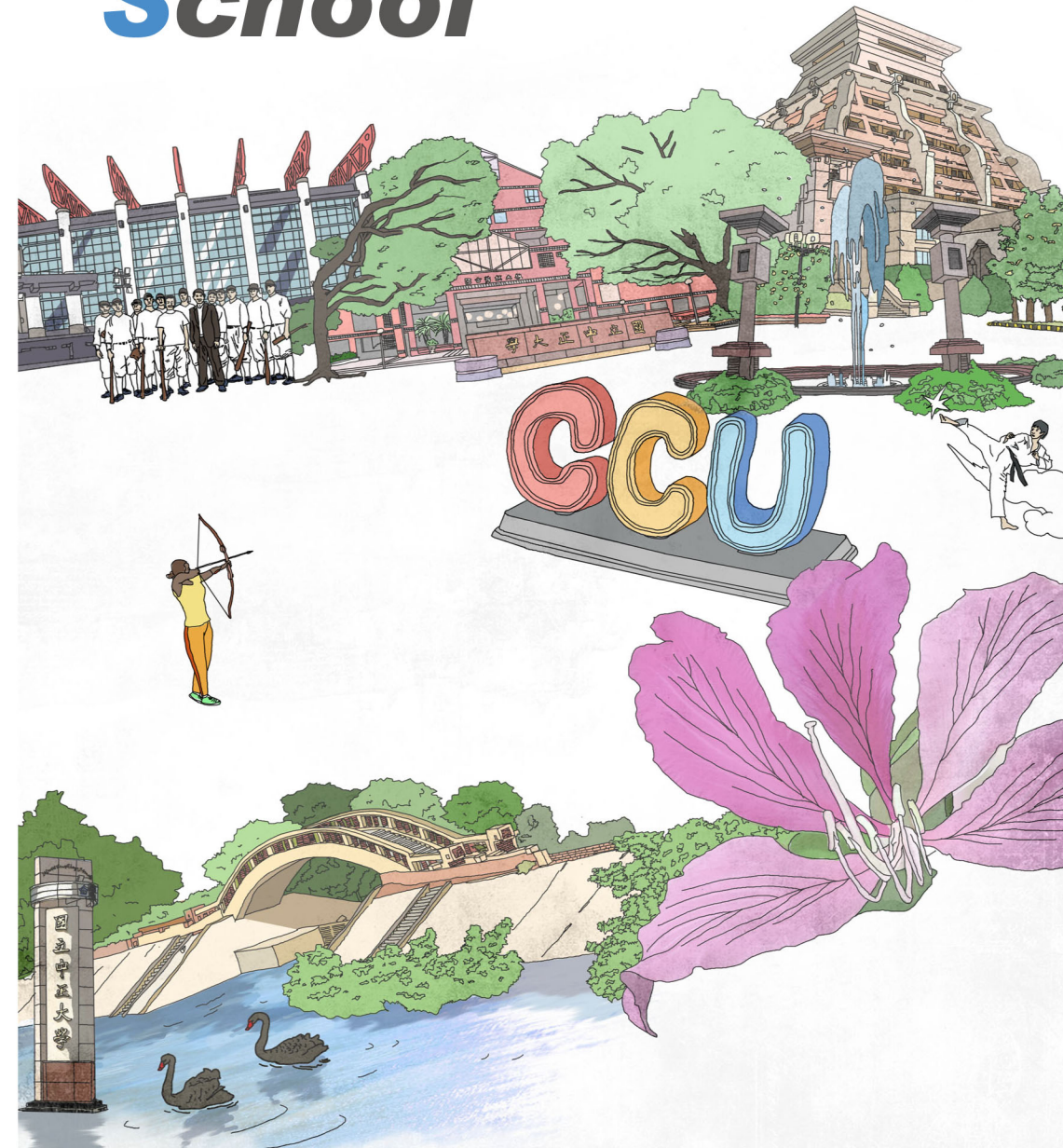

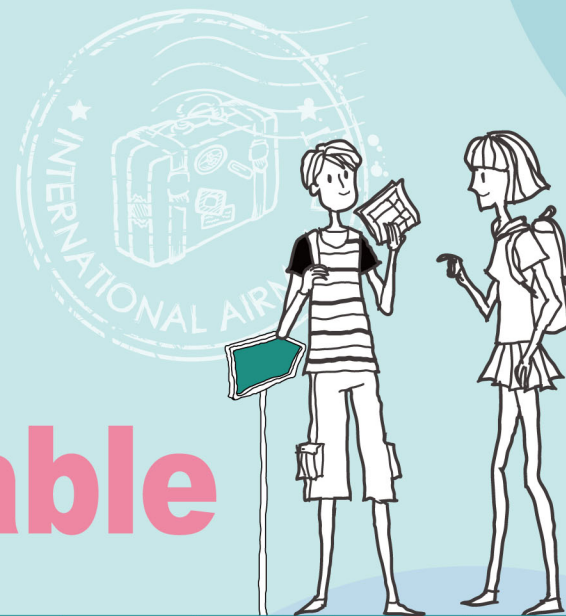


Student will take 1 academic course in the morning and 1 side program in the afternoon for each session.
