Admissions Procedures

- International Application** – Complete the General Application located online. The link is: <https://ssl.mansfield.edu/forms/intlapply.cfm>

Application Fee – A \$25.00 USD application fee is required. The fee may be paid by credit card online or by a dollar check drawn on a U.S. bank or an international money order obtainable from banks or American Express offices. All transactions must be in U.S. funds and made payable to Mansfield University. The link of online payment is: <https://ssl.mansfield.edu/forms/payment.cfm>

Financial Documents – U.S. law mandates that international students prove that they can support their estimated annual cost. Students must submit an original certified letter from the sponsor and the sponsor's bank indicating the amount of money available to the student.
- Financial Certification Insert Form** – Print and complete the form and mail it to the Admissions Office. The link is: <http://admissions.mansfield.edu/media/files/Financial%20Identification%20Insert.pdf>

Official Academic Records – Applicants are required to send official certified copies of all academic records by postal mail to the Admissions Office. When possible, records should be sent directly from the academic institution attended and contained in a sealed envelope.

Personal Statement – Applicants must submit a written personal statement or essay. This statement gives us a chance to get a personal impression of you, an insight that is not possible through the grades and numbers that make up the remainder of our application.
- English Test Scores** – Applicants from countries where English is not the official language are required to submit official results of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam, or the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). English as a Second Language (ESL) classes are available for applicants who do not meet the proficiency requirements. School Code: 2655
